AMERICAN EXPERIENCE

Freedom Riders: Find inspiration in the story of a courageous band of young civil-rights activists who journeyed through the Deep South in 1961.

Clinton: Explore the history of an American president who rose from a broken childhood to become one of the most successful politicians in modern American history.

The Amish: Find answers to questions Americans have about this insistently insular religious community.

American Masters - Cab Calloway Sketches: A singer, dancer and band leader, he was an exceptional figure in the history of jazz: he charmed audiences around the world with boundless energy, bravado and elegant showmanship.

Cave People of the Himalaya: Adventurer-hikers search of the caves and mummies of a lost civilization, and risk their own safety to reveal astonishing evidence of a previously unknown, 1500-year-old death ritual high in the Himalayan caves.

David Suchet on the Orient Express: With glamour, insight, charm, beautiful photography, and fascinating stories, David Suchet ("Poirot") leads viewers on a blissfully homicide-free excursion aboard the modern-day Orient Express.

FRONTLINE

The Interrupters: Former gang leaders try to "interrupt" shootings and protect their communities.

GREAT PERFORMANCES

Memphis: Turn back the dial to the 1950s in this Tony Award-winning musical about an interracial couple whose love for music, and each other, is put to the test.

Iceberg That Sank the Titanic: Every iceberg is unique, moulded by its ocean journey as it splits, fractures and melts each day. What were the origins of the iceberg that sealed the fate of the Titanic in April 1912?

Inside Nature's Giants: Veterinary specialists and biologists perform autopsies on a large wild animals to uncover the secrets hidden within anatomy.

Looking for Lincoln: Dr. Henry Louis Gates, Jr. addresses outstanding questions surrounding Abraham Lincoln, about race, equality, religion and depression, by interpreting the evidence provided by people who knew him.

NOVA

Extreme Cave Diving: Dr. Kenny Broad dives into blue holes, underwater caves that formed during the last ice age.

Ice Age Death Trap: Archaeologists uncover a unique site packed with preserved bones from the Ice Age.

Japan's Killer Quake: Get a unique look at the science behind Japan's catastrophic 2011 earthquake.

Separating Twins: Witness the surgery that will allow twin girls, born joined at the head, to live separate lives.

Slavery By Another Name: Explore the little-known story of the labor practices and laws that effectively created a new form of slavery in the South that persisted into the 20th century. Laurence Fishburne narrates.

Space Shuttle - A Horizon Guide: Offers a look back at the 30-year run of NASA's space shuttle program.

The Blood Sugar Solution with Dr. Hyman: Offers solutions for losing weight and preventing diabetes, heart disease, stroke, dementia, and cancer through balanced insulin levels.

The Blues - In Performance at the White House: A celebration of the musical form that sprang from the Mississippi Delta to the Westside of Chicago, with deep roots in Africa and slavery, and influences on modern American music.

Underground Railroad - The William Still Story: Extraordinary people risked their lives to help fugitive slaves escape via the clandestine Underground Railroad, including William Still, a free black man from Philadelphia.
